

## **AGENDA ITEM 11**

Information from Cllr Stabler as requested by Parish Council regarding an additional defibrillator.

Thank you for contacting the British Heart Foundation today, it was lovely speaking to you, and great to hear you are looking at installing an additional defibrillator in your Village.

I have detailed below a couple of suggestions for a suitable device; these both have multifunctional pads and are suitable for use on both adults and children, without the need to purchase additional paediatric pads. I have also included costs for replacement pads and batteries when needed and your options for the external heated cabinets. I hope you find the information helpful-

### **iPAD NFK200**

- Multifunctional pads, suitable for use on both adults and children
- Child button mode
- CPR Metronome
- Small, lightweight and portable
- Guides users using voice prompts and indicators
- USB connectivity to download rescue data
- CPR detection and step indicator- shows how many cycles of CPR have been performed.
- 10 year warranty
- Semi automatic

#### **External Cabinets -**

Defibrillators that are sited outdoors will need to be housed in an external, heated cabinet. These have a small heating element inside them to ensure the device is kept at the correct operating temperature. Freezing temperatures will affect the battery, and the device will not work.

External cabinets are supplied with a 3-pin plug, however we do recommend that they are hard wired to the mains electricity by a qualified electrician. We suggest that 2-3 quotes are obtained for this work. External cabinets are available in both locked and unlocked options –

#### **Defibsafe 3 External Defibrillator Cabinet @ £630.00**

- IP 66 rating

- Flexibility in allowing you to choose locked or unlocked mode
- Provides feedback on its own operational status
- Audible Alarm when door is opened
- LED screen- displays temperature and locked/unlocked status
- Highly visible

Defibrillators are designed to be low maintenance. We recommend that the device is checked once a week to ensure it has not been used and is in good working condition with sufficient pad and battery life. Every device will have an indicator to show it is Rescue Ready and will do their own self checks on a regular basis. They will not need any ongoing servicing or maintenance.

Pads will normally have a shelf life of up to 2 years (unless otherwise specified) and will need replacing if they are used. Defibrillator batteries are non-rechargeable, and will last up to 4-5 years on standby, when a new one will need to be purchased.

Once you have received and installed your defibrillator, it would be great if you can register it on The Circuit, the UK's national defibrillator network (NDN). Once registered, your local ambulance service will know the location and availability of your device, and also have access to any keycodes for locked cabinets.
