This is XXXXXXXXXXXX, resident in Lea Rigg.

Further to my last email when I told you about the total lack of interest from the Police re the revival of Speedwatch.

The traffic on the top road is now becoming so dangerous that we residents of Lea Rigg now frequently find it quite dangerous to turn onto the 'top road' or 'Old Durham Road'. The stretch from Chantry Place to the garage is very dangerous and we often dare not turn right because of the speed of cars from the Chantry Place direction.

The road is also used for deliberate speeding and anti-social speeding (cars and quad bikes) late at night.

Unbelievably, whilst turning into the village at the first entrance after East Rainton (Allenson View) I was actually over-taken by a car which then disappeared towards the garage by the time I got to the cemetery. An act of blatant foolishness on a blind bend.

This road desperately needs the speed humps which East Rainton has had installed.

Please let me know when the Parish Council considers this matter and what action is taken.
